Of the 208 cases arraigned on PL 221.10(1) or PL 221.05 charges since August 1, 2018:

- 66.8% (139 cases) were dismissed at arraignment.
- 17.8% (37 cases) were Adjourned in Contemplation of Dismissal/Marijuana. These cases were screened prior to August 1.
- 5.53% (23 cases) were prosecuted under the “demonstrated public safety threat” exemption to the marijuana policy.
- 1.20% (5 cases) were prosecuted under the “cases against sellers” exemption to the marijuana policy.
- 0.24% (1 case) were joined to another pending case.
